Sub: Model Making and Technical Paper Presentation Competition as a part of 9<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day Celebration – Reg.

As Indian Maritime University is due to celebrate its 09<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> Nov 2016, various types of competitions have been planned. This year two new competitions are being introduced– one being Model Making competition and the second one is Technical Paper Presentation.

**Model Making Competition:**

The competition will be held at two levels – namely Campus level and University level. The Model making team may consist of maximum 10 members. The models will be first evaluated at Campus level and will have Campus Level Prize as shown below:

The top two models from each Campus will be brought to the Headquarters for University Level evaluation. From these top three models will be given prizes by the University. The Prize will be as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Prize	-	Rs. 20,000/-

3 <sup>rd</sup> Prize	-	Rs. 12,000/-

Technical Paper Presentation:

The competition will also be held at two levels – Campus level and University Level. The Technical Papers will first evaluated at Campus level and the best paper(s) will be further evaluated at University Level . The weightage for the same will be as 70% for content of the paper and rest 30% will be for presentation. There may be a maximum of 5 members in the team preparing the Technical Paper. The Technical Papers will be presented School-wise at the Campus. The number of prizes School-wise is as shown below:

Marine Engineering	-	3 Prizes
Nautical Science	-	2 Prizes
Naval Architecture	-	2 Prizes
Management	-	2 Prizes

At the University Level a panel of experts will be constituted to evaluate the papers selected by the Campus to select three best Technical papers. The three best will be given Prize on the foundation Day and the Prize for the three best Technical Papers will be as shown below:

1 <sup>st</sup> Prize	-	Rs. 10,000/-
2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize	-	Rs. 8,000/-
3 <sup>rd</sup> Prize	-	Rs. 6,000/-
