Sub: Amendments to Ordinance No.1 of 2014: (i) to include AMET's 3-year 'Diploma in Naval Architecture & Off-shore Engineering' programme as a qualifying course for admission by Lateral Entry into the 2nd year of IMU's 4-year B.Tech (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering) programme, and (ii) to include IMU's 'Diploma in Nautical Science' programme as a qualifying course for admission by Lateral Entry into the 2nd year of B.Sc (Nautical Science) programme.

The Executive Council in its 37th Meeting held on 22-12-2016 vide Agenda Item No: EC 2016-36-11 resolved to approve the following amended Ordinance No. 1 of 2014, as recommended by the Academic Council in its 16th meeting held on 08.12.2016 vide Agenda Item No. AC 2016-16-25:

"Guidelines for Admissions by Lateral Entry into the Second year of B.Tech (Marine Engineering), B.Tech (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering) and B.Sc (Nautical Science)"

B.Tech (Marine Engineering):

- 1) The candidate should have a Diploma in Mechanical Engineering (or) Diploma in Marine Engineering from any Institute approved by AICTE with at least 60% marks overall and should have completed the diploma within the stipulated period of 3 years.

- 2) The candidate should have secured 50% marks in English in 10th standard or 12th standard.
- 3) Age limit – 18 to 25 years.
- 4) Lateral Entry admissions should be made only to the available vacant seats at the beginning of the second year.

B.Tech (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering):

- 1) The candidate should have either a B.Sc (Ship-building and Repair) with at least 60% marks overall and should have completed the degree within the stipulated period of 3 years.

(or)

Diploma in Ship Building Engineering from the Institute of Ship Building Technology, Goa

(or)

Diploma in Naval Architecture and Offshore Engineering from the AMET University, Chennai with at least 60% marks overall and should have completed the diploma within the stipulated period of 3 years.

(or)

Diploma in Mechanical Engineering/Civil Engineering from any Institute approved by AICTE with at least 60% marks overall and should have completed the diploma within the stipulated period of 3 years.

- 2) Age limit – 18 to 25 years.
- 3) Lateral Entry admissions should be made only to the available vacant seats at the beginning of the second year.
- 4) While making admissions, candidates will be taken, one at a time, from each of the above 3 streams by rotation.

B.Sc (Nautical Science):

- 1) The candidate should have passed (i) the 1-year Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS) programme and (ii) IMU's Online Common Entrance Test specific to Lateral Entry candidates. ✓

2) All passed-out DNS students including those admitted in the February 2016 batch of DNS are eligible to appear in the Online CET for Lateral Entry into 2nd year B.Sc(Nautical Science) in 2017-18. Thereafter, from the academic year 2018-19 onwards, Lateral Entry will be restricted only to candidates who had passed DNS within five years from the year in which lateral entry into 2nd year B.Sc (Nautical Science) is sought.

Illustration: Only DNS passed candidates admitted in August 2012 batch or later will be eligible to appear for the Online CET for Lateral Entry into 2nd year B.Sc (Nautical Science) in August 2018.

3) Age limit – 18 to 25 years.

4) Lateral Entry admissions should be made only to the available vacant seats at the beginning of the second year.”

It is hereby informed to all the IMU campuses and Affiliated Institutions that the above norms may be strictly followed while giving admissions of students in the Lateral Entry into the Second Year of B.Tech (Marine Engineering) and B.Tech (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering) and B.Sc(Nautical Science).

After the admissions, the original certificates may be sent to the Head Quarters of IMU for verification and to get the allotment letters.

This Ordinance will come into force with effect from the Academic year 2017-18 onwards.
