Admissions will be made in the order of merit based on the total available number of seats vacant and aggregate percentage of marks in their respective diploma.

The applications received will be scrutinized category wise based on the age and qualifying educational criterion and shortlisted based on merit only. The shortlisted candidates will be intimated by e-mail within 2-3 working days.

B. The shortlisted candidates will be required to report at IMU, Chennai Campus for verification of certificates & counseling on **18th September 2020 (Friday)** between 1000 hrs and 1600 hrs.
