The eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall be **one among** the following :

Candidates who have passed SSLC (10th or 11th class/grade and PUC or higher secondary (12th grade) before joining undergraduate (UG) programme (3 or more years) and UG before joining PG degree programme, i.e. 10+2+UG Degree (3 or more years) or 11+1+ UG Degree (3 or more years)

AND

The Post Graduate* (P.G) shall be in the respective areas of research in the Schools mentioned in previous slide or a relevant discipline with at least 55% marks or equivalent Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). For SC/ ST/ OBC(NCL)/ PwD candidates, the minimum marks shall be 50% (or equivalent CGPA).

- 2. M.S (by Research) or M.Phil degree in the respective areas of research in the Schools mentioned in previous slide or a relevant discipline.
- 3. Mariners with Master or MEO Class I Certificate of Competency or PGDMOM qualification with 2 years of continuous teaching experience at degree level as faculty in IMU/IMU Affiliated Institutes/DG(S) approved institutes, shall be eligible till the Academic Year 2023-24.

*<u>Note</u>: Candidates having PG from Foreign Universities are required to mandatorily submit Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (AIU), if selected.



Under Graduate (U.G) degree with 10+2+(3 or 4) pattern in a relevant discipline with at least 55% marks or equivalent Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA), except in the case of Mariners for whom a Master or MEO Class I Certificate of Competency would suffice. For SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/PwD candidates, the minimum marks shall be 50% (or equivalent CGPA). Under Graduate (U.G) degree with 10+2+(3 or 4) pattern in a relevant discipline with at least 55% marks or equivalent Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA), except in the case of Mariners for whom a Master or MEO Class I Certificate of Competency would suffice. For SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/PwD candidates, the minimum marks shall be 50% (or equivalent CGPA).



- The Written Test (Stage I) in Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) to test a Candidate's General Mental Ability, knowledge on the Maritime sector, and knowledge on the relevant discipline/area of research in which the Candidate proposes to do the Ph.D/Integrated Ph.D. or M.S (By Research). This shall have 40% weightage. This test will have 120 Questions and the time duration is 2 hours.
- Descriptive writing Test (Stage II) to assess proficiency in technical writing & English will be in the general area in which the Candidate is interested to do research. This shall have 30% weightage. Time duration for this will be 1 hour.
- Personal Interview (Stage III) by the Departmental Committee which will be conducted at IMU Headquarters for the qualifying Candidates at a later date shall have 30% weightage.
- To qualify to the Stage II, the Candidate should secure minimum 50% in Stage I. To qualify to the Stage III, the Candidate should secure minimum 50% in Stage II.
- For the convenience of the Candidates, Descriptive Writing Test (Stage II) will be conducted immediately after the Written Test (Stage I) at the same test venue. However the answer scripts of those Candidates who secure 50% or more in Stage I will be evaluated to finalize the list of Candidates eligible for Personal Interview (Stage III).
- Candidate may choose to join the programme in Full time or Part time.

1	What is the duration & difference between Ph.D. & Integrated Ph.D. & MS (By Research)?			
Г	A PhD is a postgraduate doctoral degree, usually completed after a Masters degree. PhD students carry out independent research towards an original thesis in their subject and receive the title 'Doctor' upon			
	successful completion of their degree.			
	Integrated PhD is a programme which involves students taking postgraduate level courses before progressing onto standard PhD research.			
	The MS (by Research) program is a post graduate degree for students who want to kick-start their research career. The program emphasizes the use of logical, analytical, experimental and intuitive thinking skills in			
	the pursuit of research.			
	In IMU, the minimum & maximum duration is as given below:			
	Ph.D Part Time – 4 & 7 years and Full Time – 3 & 6 years			
	Integrated Ph.D. – Part Time – 5 & 8 years and Full Time – 4 & 7 years			
L	MS (By Research) - Part Time – 3 & 4 years and Full Time – 2 & 3 years			
2	What is the basis for Admission decision?			
	Admission decision will be the based on the scores obtained in entrance test and interview.			
	An entrance test will be conducted that comprises of Written Objective Test – 120 marks (1 mark each) followed by an essay test of 1 hour duration.			
	Qualified candidates in the above test will be called for interview.			
L	Suitable number of candidates will be selected for admissions who qualify the above stages of admission.			
3	What is Part Time/Full Time - Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D./ MS (By Research)			
	A part time PhD/Integrated Ph.D./MS (By Research) is of a longer duration while a regular degree is somewhat of lesser duration.			
	Studying a part time PhD/Integrated Ph.D./MS (By Research), you can work on your research thesis from any place but you would have to stay in constant touch with your guide or sometimes you may require to visit			
	IMU Campus for research related work.			
	Studying for a full-time PhD/Integrated Ph.D./MS (By Research) is a comparable commitment to a full-time course.

5	Do all research scholars get financial assistance for pursuing a PhD program at IMU?			
-	No, only Full- Time PhD scholars are eligible to apply for it but after their selection to the PhD program.			
	Financial assistance in the form of Teaching Research Fellowship (TRF) (limited numbers) will be awarded to brilliant young researchers whose selection will be done based on a separate test of			
	a scholar receiving TRF has to teach to UG/PG students of IMU.			
	A sum of Rs. 25000 per month shall be awarded towards TRF for 3 years.			
6	Do PhDs/Integrated Ph.D./MS (By Research) have exams & what is course work in it?			
	Yes, in Ph.D. you have to take specific number of subjects (total 5 subjects, known as course work) which are required to be completed within a maximum of period of 36 months from the date of			
	registration.			
	Integrated Ph.D. has a total of 9 subjects which are required to be completed within a maximum of period of 24 months (full time candidate)/ 36 months (part time candidate) from the date of			
	registration.			
	MS (By Research) has a total of 5 subjects which are required to be completed within a maximum of period of 24 months from the date of registration.			
	A Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D./MS ends with an oral examination called a viva voce. This requires you to answer questions face-to-face with academics who are experts in your subject and have read your thesis.			
7	What is a Doctoral/Monitoring Committee in Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D.?			
	The Doctoral/Monitoring Committee will consist of 4 members: Guide, Co-Guide (if applicable) and 2 experts. This committee formed for each individual who is pursing Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D. will advise			
	and monitor him on his research.			
8	What is a Monitoring Committee in MS (By Research)?			
	A Monitoring Committee will consist of 3 members: Guide, Co-Guide (if applicable) and 1 expert. This committee formed for each individual who is pursing MS will advise and monitor him on his research.			
9	In Integrated Ph.D., can I exit with a MS (By Research)– Degree?			
	Yes, but only after completion of 3 years subject to fulfilling of requirements needed for award of a MS Degree.			
10	Can I get accommodation in IMU Campus?			
	No.			
11	Can I change the Guide?			
	Yes but it is subject to recommendations of the Doctoral/Monitoring Committee for a valid reason.

	Yes, it is mandatory for all candidates to first register online to get eligible to apply for admission.
