Teaching Research Fellowship to Ph.D Scholars in IMU

- 1. Notification for award of Teaching Research Fellowship (TRF) (limited numbers on merit basis) will be issued soon after the Ph.D. admissions are over. The Notification will include details such as no. of fellowships in each school, the selection procedure etc.
- 2. Only full-time Ph.D scholars are eligible to apply for TRF.
- 3. The selection will be based on written test and interview. Written test is an objective type test to assess the research skills of the scholar and during the interview the scholars' teaching skills may be tested.
- 4. TRF shall be awarded for 3 years only.
- 5. A sum of Rs. 25000 per month shall be awarded towards TRF for 3 years. An Annual Contingency amount of Rs. 10000 for first 2 years and Rs. 15000 for 3rd year shall be awarded.
- 6. After the award of TRF, every scholar receiving fellowship is required to take theory, practical and seminar classes for UG/PG students under the direction of the guide/HoD. The teaching load of a scholar shall not exceed 10 hours per week.
- 7. At the end of every year, the TRF is required to submit a progress report duly forwarded by the guide and HoD. The report is to be placed before the Doctoral committee/Monitoring committee for recommendation on continuity of the fellowship.
- 8. The fellowship shall be stopped if the progress of the scholar is not satisfied.
- 9. If a scholar wants to relinquish/exit from the TRF position, he/she may submit a requisition. The guide/HoD shall forward the same to the Vice Chancellor for approval. However, the Ph.D admission would be retained for the scholar if the scholar wishes to continue his/her Ph.D.
