It is proposed to fill the seats available for the B.Tech (Marine Engineering) programme being conducted at IMU, Kolkata campus for Academic Year 2017-2018 through lateral entry scheme (admission into 2nd year).

Indian Maritime University invites applications from eligible candidates fulfilling the educational and other eligibility criteria for the UG program at its Kolkata Campus through the lateral entry scheme.

1. Age Limit:

- i) Minimum age 18 years
- ii) Maximum age 26 years

<u>Note</u>: For Scheduled Caste (SC) & Schedule Tribe (ST) candidates maximum age relaxation is for five (5) years.

2. <u>Educational Qualifications</u> :

a. 3 years Diploma in Marine Engineering from any Institute approved by AICTE with at least 60% marks and a minimum of 50% marks in English subject in 10th/12th Examination. The candidate should have completed the diploma within its stipulated duration of 3 years.

b. 3 years Diploma in Mechanical Engineering from any Institute approved by AICTE with at least 60% marks and a minimum of 50% marks in English subject in 10th/12th Examination. The candidate should have completed the diploma within its stipulated duration of 3 years.

3. <u>No. of seats vacant</u>: Total No of seats vacant are **36** and admissions will be made in the order of merit based on aggregate percentage of marks in their respective diploma.

A. Interested candidates should download the application form from <u>www.imu.edu.in</u>, <u>www.merical.ac.in</u> and submit the same along with selfattested copies of certificates and mark sheets by post so as to reach the following address on or before 1st July 2017.

The applications received will be scrutinised category wise based on the age and qualifying educational criterion and shortlisted based on merit only. The list of shortlisted and waitlist candidates will be put up in the website **www.merical.ac.in**. The shortlisted candidates will also be intimated by e-mail.

B. The shortlisted candidates will be required to report at IMU, Kolkata Campus for verification of certificates & counselling on <u>10th July 2017</u> <u>between 1000 hrs and 1600 hrs.</u> The following certificates should be produced in original at the time of counselling.

- I. SSC / 10th Standard Mark sheet (for proof of date of birth)
- II. Provisional Certificate / Degree or Diploma Certificate as applicable
- III. Course Completion Certificate (if provisional certificate is not issued)
- IV. Statement of Marks of all Semester / Academic Years.
- V. Approved Medical Fitness Certificate from DGS approved doctors complying with MS Act.

C. After verification of certificates, the candidate will be issued the admission letter.

D. IMU reserves the right to allocate any leftover seats in any category to waitlisted candidates in that category or to any other remaining categories.

E. The Selected candidates will have to report at IMU, Kolkata Campus and register for the 3rd semester on 17 July 2017.

5. Fee Particulars:

A. An Application Fee for Rs.1000/- for General candidates and Rs.700/- for schedule Caste /Scheduled Tribe candidates to be paid along with the submission of application in the form of Demand draft payable at Kolkata in favour of Indian Maritime University, Kolkata campus.

B. Upon confirmation of admission, the candidates are instructed to pay the following fee at the time of reporting to IMU, Kolkata campus for formal registration on **17 July 2017**.

I. A Counselling Fee of Rs.10,000/- through a Demand Draft in favour of Indian Maritime University, Kolkata Campus payable at Kolkata.

II. **Rs.25,000/-** towards **Programme Fee** through Demand Draft in favour of **Indian Maritime University, payable at Chennai**.

III. The Semester Fee of Rs.1,00,000/- should be paid at the campus for 3rd semester fee on the day of registration through a Demand Draft in favour of Indian Maritime University, Kolkata Campus payable at Kolkata.

IV. A Fee of Rs.20,000/- should be paid at the campus as Caution Deposit (refundable) through a Demand Draft in favour of Indian Maritime University, Kolkata Campus payable at Kolkata.

C. Balance fee for 2nd year **Rs.1,00,000/-** will be paid in the month of **February 2018.**
