## Most Important & Urgent CIRCULAR UNIVERSITY DAY 2014 CELEBRATIONS – INTER-CAMPUS CULTURAL COMPETITION

The Indian Maritime University celebrates **University Day** every year on 14<sup>th</sup> November at each Campus to commemorate its Birth Anniversary. But the Chief Guest (Hon'ble Union Minister/Secretary, Shipping etc) used to attend the University Day function at IMU Headquarters at Chennai only. In a departure from this practice, this year it is proposed to involve all the Campuses in the University Day celebrations at Chennai. And, for the first time, it is proposed to conduct an **inter-Campus Cultural Competition** for students of IMU as part of the University Day celebrations this year. The following 12 cultural events are proposed: 1. Debate, 2. General Quiz, 3. Just a Minute, 4. Dumb Charade, 5. Sketching, 6. Painting, 7. Collage, 8. Standup Comedy, 9. Mimicry, 10. Singing, 11. Solo Dance and 12. Group Dance. The number of participants / teams allowed for each Campus for each event and the approximate duration of each event during the 'Finals' held at Chennai are indicated in the **Annexure** to this Circular.

In this connection, the following instructions are issued:

1. Individual Campuses must select their top 2 participants or 1 Team (as the case may be) for each cultural event by holding 'Heats'/preliminary competitions at their Campus level. This should be done before 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 and the names of

- participants from the Campus should be intimated to IMU HQ before 5PM on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2014.
- 2. The expenditure for the conduct of the preliminary competitions at the Campus level shall be borne by the respective Campuses from the Campus Development Fund (Account No.6).
- 3. A Campus should not depute participants in excess of the numbers specified.
- 4. The Campus Director is invited to attend the University Day celebrations at IMU HQ along with one Faculty member and two support staff (instructors/warden/non-teaching staff). The Faculty member and the support staff will be responsible for the roll call and discipline of participants all through the duration of the 'Finals'.
- 5. The cost of to and fro passage to Chennai of the visiting teams (including Campus Directors etc) will be reimbursed by IMU HQ. All expenses of the conduct of the 'Finals' at Chennai including boarding & lodging will be borne by IMU HQ.
- 6. Campus Directors are requested to organize the 'Heats'/preliminary competitions on a war footing (and at the same time in a transparent manner). They should plan the trip of their participants to Chennai in advance so as to reach IMU-Chennai by the afternoon of 12<sup>th</sup> November 2014 and depart from Chennai in the forenoon of 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, preferably early morning. A briefing session for all participants will be held at IMU HQ on 12<sup>th</sup> November evening.
- 7. The 'Finals' of the events will be held throughout 13<sup>th</sup> November with a few events on 14<sup>th</sup> November forenoon. The winning teams of some of the cultural events will be required to perform on 14<sup>th</sup> November at the time of the University Day celebrations in the presence of the Chief Guest.

8. Handsome prizes will be awarded to the winners and runners-up of each event. In addition, there will also be an <a href="Individual Championship Award">Individual Championship Award</a> and an overall <a href="Championship Rolling Trophy to the Best Campus">Championship Rolling</a>

All Campus Directors are requested to make the University Day celebrations 2014 and the Inter-Campus Cultural Competition a grand success. This circular as well as the Annexure should be displayed on Notice Boards for the information of the students.
