The Executive Council in its 54th Meeting held on 09-07-2020 vide Agenda Item No: EC 2020-54-09 resolved to approve the amended Ordinance No. 26 of 2018 (Gazette No:350), prescribing the 'Minimum Eligibility Criteria for admissions to the various programmes in IMU' as recommended by the Academic Council in its 27th meeting held on 01.07.2020 vide Agenda Item-No-AC 2020-27-09. Further the Executive Council in its 56th Meeting held on 06-10-2020 vide Agenda Item No: EC 2020-56-01 has approved minor corrections in the Agenda AC 2020-27-09 and the finally approved the amendment to the Ordinance No:26 of 2018 and the Ordinance 26 of 2018 published in the Official Gazette No. 350 dated 12.09.2018 is repealed and the revised Ordinance 06 of 2020 has been approved as follows:

"Ordinance prescribing the Minimum Eligibility Criteria for admissions to the various programmes in IMU"
