Educational and other qualifications required	<p>A.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A Master’s Degree in Physical education and Sports or Physical Education or Sports Science with an 5% mark (or an equivalent grade on a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed)</li> <li>ii. Record of having represented the University/College at the inter-university/inter-collegiate competitions or the State and/or national championships.</li> <li>iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET), conducted by the UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET. Or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in Physical education or Physical Education and Sports or Sports Science, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be: Provide that, candidates register for the Ph.D. degree prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provision of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye-laws/regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. degree holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:- <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode;</li> <li>b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least an external examiner;</li> <li>c) Open Ph.D. voce of the candidate has been conducted;</li> <li>d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;</li> <li>e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers in conference/seminar, based in his/her Ph.D. work.</li> </ol> <p><i>Note: The fulfillment of these conditions) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.</i></p> </li> <li>iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for the Masters’ Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.</li> <li>v. Passed the physical fitness test conducted in accordance with these Regulations.</li> </ol> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(OR)</b></p> <p>B. An Asian game or commonwealth games medal winner who has a degree at least at Post-Graduation level.</p>

Remarks	<p><b>Physical Fitness Test Norms</b></p> <p>(a) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test are required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.</p> <p>(b) On the production of such certificate mentioned in sub-clause (a) above, the candidate would be requires to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:</p> <p><b>NORMS FOR MEN</b></p> <p>12 Minutes Run/Walk Test</p> <p>Upto 30 Years – 1800 Metres  Upto 40 Years – 1500 Metres  Upto 45 Years – 1200 Metres  Upto 50 Years - 800 Metres</p>
