**Minutes of the Meeting held Online of the Head of Departments/Officers of the Government of India by the Central Government Employees Welfare Co-Ordination Committee (CGEWCC) on 27.11.2024 at 3.00 PM through MS-Teams Meeting App.**

The meeting of Head of Departments/Officers of the Government of India was held by the Central Government Employees Welfare Co-ordination Committee (CGEWCC), Mumbai online through MS-Teams meeting on 27.11.2024 at 3.00 PM.

The meeting, commenced at 3.00 PM, was chaired by Shri Sandeep Raj, Commissioner of Income-tax (Admn. & TPS), Mumbai and Chairman, Central Government Employees Welfare Co-ordination Committee (CGEWCC) Mumbai. The meeting was attended by Shri Amit Sanjay Gurav, Addl. Commissioner of Income-tax (HQ) Personnel & Gen. Secretary, CGEWCC, Mumbai, Shri Vishal V. Sakore, Dy. Commissioner of Income Tax (HQ)(Pers.), Mumbai, Shri Ritesh Kumar, Income Tax Officer & Jt. Secretary, CGEWCC, Mumbai, Dr. Viraj S Karuley, Chief Medical officer in charge, CGHS, Mumbai, Shri Salil Ahire, members of Income Tax Gazetted Officers' Association, Mumbai, Shri Laxman Yeram, Shri Anoop S, Shri Arun Poojari members of Income Tax Employees Federation (ITEF), Mumbai. Further, 32 Officers/Officials from various Central Government Offices in and around Mumbai also attended the online meeting.

Shri Amit Sanjay Gurav, Gen. Secretary CGEWCC started the meeting by welcoming all Officers/Officials from various Central Government Offices and members of the Committee.

As per the agenda, the following issues were discussed :

3. HOLIDAYS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2025:

The primary agenda of the meeting was selection of 3 additional holidays [in addition to the 14 compulsory holidays] in the State of Maharashtra for the Calendar year 2025 out of the 12 holidays as listed in para 3.1 of the Office Memorandum (F.No.12/2/2023-JCA) dated 09.07.2024 issued by the Department of Personnel & Training, New Delhi.

The issue was deliberated upon in the online meeting. Considering the suggestions received from members who attended the meeting, representations received from various departments including CGEWCC, Nagpur and Pune and after reckoning the significance of such

festivals in the State of Maharashtra, it was decided by the CGEWCC to add the following 3 holidays in addition to the 14 compulsory holidays to the Holiday List of the Calendar Year 2025.

As enunciated in Para 5.1 of the Office Memorandum dated 09.07.2024 issued by DoPT and as unanimously decided, the date of the following holidays shall be changed, subject to the decision of the Government of State of Maharashtra, which shall be treated as the final date of the holidays :

In addition to this, certain other issues were also discussed which are as under:

1. Issue in respect of CS(MA) [Central Services (Medical Attendance)] beneficiary was raised how they have to take the treatment in empaneled Hospital in absence of the CGHS Card. Dr. Viraj from CGHS informed that the Departmental ID card is sufficient for availing the medical facility in the CGHS empaneled Hospital. If the treatment is denied by any Hospital, a complaint may be lodged with the Additional Director CGHS so that action may be taken. Further, it is brought to the Notice that the AMA [Authorised Medical Attendant] Card may also be issued by the respective HoDs to their employees who are not residing under CGHS covered area.
2. The members from CGEWCC & other department member requested that CGHS wellness center should be opened in Thane. Dr. Viraj from CGHS replied that the suitable premises are being searched for wellness centre. However, the same has not been found as of now. Dr. Viraj assured that they are trying to open a CGHS Wellness Centre in Thane City as early as possible.
3. The members from ITEF raised the concern over large number of beneficiaries enlisted with the Belapur Wellness Centre and requested that CGHS wellness center should be opened in Vashi & Panvel, Navi Mumbai. Dr. Viraj from CGHS informed that the process is going on to open a CGHS Wellness Centre in Panvel.



4. Shri Amol Sule, NFICGA Mumbai raised the issue regarding closure of wellness centre at Oshiwara. He stated that a letter has also been written to the CGHS regarding the same. Dr. Viraj informed that for the Oshiwara wellness center, the suitable premises are being searched for. However, the same has not been found as of now.
5. It was requested to the members that if they face any common issue, they may bring it to the notice of CGEWCC also. 
